Dear Parents and Carers,

We've had a great start to the half term with 2 trips already! On Tuesday, the Rabbits class visited the Lowry museum and took part in a fantastic art workshop. Ahead of World Book Day, which we are celebrating this Thursday 6th March, public libraries are hosting their highly successful Fancy Dress Swaps again this year from 1st February. Using the scheme could not be easier: donate any unwanted costumes to the library or see what outfits they have and take them for no charge, it's that simple. that it will finish at 2pm. Children can be collected after the service from school. Play Smart will be open from 2.15pm – 5pm for their craft afternoon for any child who wishes to stay in school.

On St George's Day, 23rd April, any children who would like to wear their Scouting Uniform to gain their Represent badge are more than welcome to.

I am pleased to announce that between 10th and 21st March, we will be undertaking flood protection work and addressing the car park's condition. I will provide specific dates for any potential alterations to collection procedures once specific days have been confirmed.

In the summer term, we will trial a new approach to swimming lessons, with the entire Badgers class and non 25m swimmers from Foxes attending sessions at City Baths for six weeks.
